Parish Council Report

- Local Government Changes
 - One or Two Unitary councils for Bucks
 - One Unitary Council decided
 - Comes into effect 1st April 2020
 - Shadow Council currently in operation
 - 17 members from County and 4 Districts



Parish Council Report

- Planning
 - 6 New applications commented upon within the Parish
- Major Planning Issues
 - Nash Park – Gt. Horwood Parish
 - Ongoing litigation and enforcement –police help
 - Church Farm additional application
 - 9 House Application
 - Still awaiting adjudication
 - Strong opposition from Parish council and residents
 - Church Farm reinstatement
 - Currently work in progress



Parish Council Report

- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Grass Cutting, Hedging etc.
 - Devolved to NPC with BCC part contribution
 - £1,522 paid by BCC but cost to NPC £2,800
 - Village Pond Cleared (again)
 - Duck house repaired (again)
 - Duck & Moorhen News
 - Posts and village signs repaired and cleaned
 - Planting and bank improvements completed (Lavender, Rosemary & saplings)
 - Transparency Code compliance
 - Government Grant funded and completed
 - Separate NPC website from Village Website working well
 - Preparation for GDPR
 - Policy completed
 - Registered with the ICO



Parish Council Report

- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Emergency Plan
 - On parish council website when completed
 - Vulnerable residents to be identified.
 - New Internal Auditor appointed
 - Mr M Richardson
 - Play around the Parishes
 - Circa 25 children attended



Parish Council Report

- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Precept 2018 / 2019
 - Previously £13,300 now set at £13,573
 - Grass Cutting etc.
 - Village maintenance
 - 2% increase in overall terms
 - Fire Works
 - Parish council considered a complaint
 - No Parish Council powers exist but a village advice was produced.



Parish Council Report

- Parish Council concerns
 - Footpath Stratford Road (BCC)
 - Some remedial work needed
 - Residents advised about damage accountability
 - Roads (gutters) were swept by AVDC at the end of May 2018 (High street still a concern)
 - Winslow Road & Little Horwood road junction work completed(BCC)

- **S106 community grant**
 - No other proposed projects
 - Signposted Historic Nash walk
 - Recreation Ground equipment
 - Village Hall improvements

Annual Parish Meeting

- **To consider the progress of the Neighbourhood Plan for Nash.**
 - Neighbourhood Plan for Nash (available on NPC web site)
 - Project Group (7 residents) has submitted final draft (available on NPC web site)
 - Over 20 planning meetings
 - Parish Council objective to have a “made plan”
 - To reflect the wishes of the majority of residents
 - 100 % of Nash residents have been consulted
 - Estimated 35% of adult residents commented
 - Target for the “made plan” pre Christmas 2019.



Annual Parish Meeting

- Neighbourhood Plan for Nash
 - Notice delivery to every residence validated
 - Key proposals & considerations
 - No Large Developments
 - Growth of approximately a further 15 houses.
 - Ideally gradual development wanted
 - Key responsibility for protection of identified wildlife, woodlands and wetlands.
 - Parish Farms (working) covered by different planning legislations & considerations
