Cllr Hickey proposed the co-option of Mr Keith Hofgartner to Nash Parish Council and the motion was seconded by Cllr Phillips. NPC unanimously resolved to approve the motion.

Cllr York formally offered his resignation after 13 years in office, and the Chair offered him his thanks for the time and effort he had given to the Parish Council.

Cllr Hickey advised that she would also be resigning from the council with immediate effect and that she would send her formal letter of resignation to the Chair. Cllr Hickey explained her reasons for leaving and her reasons for voting against the co-option of one of the candidates. The Chair once again offered his thanks to Cllr Hickey for her time on the Parish Council.

Mr Gary White and Mr Keith Hofgartner were invited back into the room, where they confirmed that they were willing to serve and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office before the Proper Officer.

The Chair thanked everyone for their contribution, and declared the meeting closed at 19.50.
