



 - One or Two Unitary councils for Bucks
 - One is the BCC proposed solution
 - Two preferred by the 4 District Councils


 North and South Bucks
 - Secretary of state advised "minded to" make it one.
 - Decision expected in June 2018
 - Representations to DHCLG James Brokenshire




- Planning
 - 13 Applications reviewed and commented upon
- Major Planning Issues
 - Nash Park Gt. Horwood Parish
 - Further planning Application Refused
 - Another has replaced it
 - Enforcement Action was expected shortly
 - Church Farm additional application
 - 9 House Application
 - Currently awaiting adjudication
 - Strong opposition from Parish council and residents
 - Church Farm Undeveloped Plot
 - Owner has started rebuilding



- Major Planning Issues
 - Neighbourhood Plan for Nash
 - Project Group working on final draft
 - Parish Council used grant funding AVDC
 - Residents to be consulted before final plan is made.



- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Grass Cutting, Hedging etc.
 - Devolved to NPC with BCC part contribution
 - £1,522 paid by BCC but cost to NPC £2,800
 - Village Pond Cleared
 - Duck house currently being repaired
 - Posts and village signs being repaired
 - Planting and bank improvements agreed
 - Transparency Code compliance
 - Government Grant funded
 - Separate NPC website from Village Website
 - Preparation for GDPR
 - Policy completed
 - Registered with the ICO




- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Emergency Plan in development
 - On parish council website when completed
 - New Internal Auditor appointed
 - Mr M Richardson
 - Play around the Parishes
 - 40 children attended
 - Public Footpath acquired
 - £1 plus legal costs £47



- Parish Council responsibilities
 - Precept 2018 / 2019
 - Previously £12,500 now set at £13,300
 - Grass Cutting etc.
 - Village maintenance
 - Dog Litter
 - No resolution
 - Depending upon residents



- Parish Council concerns
 - Footpath Stratford Road (BCC)
 - Outside Holywell Cottages
 - Completed
 - Some remedial work needed
 - Residents advised about damage accountability
 - Roads (gutters) scheduled for sweeping by <u>AVDC</u>
 by the end of May 2018



- S106 community grant
 - Proposed projects
 - Grant to Village Hall to improve local facilities
 - Signposted Historic Nash walk
 - Recreation Ground equipment
 - Bus Shelter conversion to Book Share library
 - Others???
